## **CHIP MemberCards**



### **Chip cards have arrived for MEMBER CARD® cards!**

The card contains an embedded microchip and offers even more security and peace of mind for your transactions. The chip provides additional protection to avoid disclosure of personal information and is very difficult to copy, creating a multi-layered defense against fraud and identity theft. The chip is located on the left-hand side of your card. It works with chip capable ATMs and point of sale terminals ensuring secure transactions and providing increased protection against card fraud.

Canadian chip cards will be fully compatible with systems in countries that have adopted chip. In countries like the U.S. that have yet to switch to chip technology or do not plan to, cardholders will be able to use their cards since the chip cards will still have a magnetic stripe. You will receive a new PIN prior to receiving your chip card. If you would like to change your PIN once you receive your chip card, you will be able to do so in the branch or at the ATM at your credit union. For your protection, if you incorrectly enter your PIN a number of times, it will be locked and you will have to contact your credit union to have it reactivated.
